

PRE-APPROVED SUMMER CONSULTING

Faculty members may participate in the below specified range of academic related consulting activities during the summer without advance filing of a consulting request form. This document establishes pre-approval for SUCH activities.

Eligible faculty are those who, during the summer, expect to have no assigned, contractual or grant related responsibilities for which they are paid by the University.

The class of pre-approved academic related activities includes:

- Educational and scientific presentations;
- Giving occasional lectures and speeches;
- Participation in colloquia, symposia, site visits, study sections and similar gatherings;
- Ad hoc refereeing of manuscripts (not to include paid editorships); and
- Remuneration for any one activity may not exceed \$1,000 with a total limit over the summer of \$10,000.

Faculty engaged in any activity covered by this pre-approval provision are still required to submit a year end reconciliation report as they would with any consulting activity.

As with all other forms of consulting, faculty are also expected to comply with the University's Policy on Consulting for Faculty and remain personally responsible for compliance with the State's Code of Ethics.
